Professor Matt Boyne came to PLNU in 2008 as an adjunct faculty member specializing in operations and project management. After graduating from the U.S. Naval Academy, he served as a Naval Aviator, flight and weapons training instructor, maintenance officer, and commanding officer while flying the F/A-18 Hornet from carriers deployed around the globe. He participated in multiple combat operations in the Middle East where he led a squadron and multi-agency task forces focused on a wide range of national security issues. He has extensive experience in leading high-performing teams, operational planning, strategic execution, logistics, and developing organizational cultures that foster excellence.

Since leaving the Navy, he has taught at the graduate level for multiple universities.
